



Winchester Republican Committee Membership Application



The Winchester Republican Committee is the governing body of the local Republican Party. All legal and qualified voters under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and reside in the City of Winchester and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, are eligible for membership on the Winchester Republican Committee.

Committee Members having voting privileges are expected to attend all regular and special meetings of the Winchester Republican Committee and volunteer their time and efforts toward party-related activities. Associate Members are highly encouraged to attend all meetings, and volunteer at party events; however, the occasional absence will not affect membership.

Annual dues: \$40.00*. Payment of dues should accompany membership application.
