OFFICIAL CALL FOR MASS MEETING

As Chairman of the Waynesboro Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Jacob Lipscomb, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at 481 Hopeman Parkway, Waynesboro, VA 22980, starting at 10:00 am local time on March 30, 2024 for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Unit Chair
2. Electing members of the Unit Committee
3. Electing up to 200 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Sixth District Republican Convention to be held on Saturday, May 11, 2024 at the Rockingham County Fairgrounds, 4808 S. Valley Pike, Harrisonburg, VA; beginning at 10 am local time for the purpose of:
 - A. Election of a District Committee Chairman to the Sixth Congressional District of the Republican Party of Virginia
 - B. Election of three District Regional Vice Chairmen to the Sixth Congressional District of the Republican Party of Virginia
 - C. Election of three representatives to the State Central Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia
 - D. Nominating an elector to vote for the Republican candidate for President
4. Electing up to 200 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the RPV

2024 Quadrennial Convention to be held on May 31-June 1, 2024, at the Hampton Roads Convention Center, 1610 Coliseum Drive, Hampton, VA 23666, beginning at 2:00 pm on May 31, and 10:00 am on June 1, local time for the purpose of:

- A. Electing two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 5, 2024
- B. Electing a State Chairman
- C. Nominating a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman
- D. For the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention

Each Unit is entitled to one Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the Waynesboro Republican Committee is entitled to 200 Delegate Votes; for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting if included in the agenda.

Qualifications for Participations

All legal and qualified voters of Waynesboro under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party of Virginia and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvass, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Any Military Member who is otherwise qualified under Article I to participate in Republican Party actions and who complies with the procedures to become a delegate to any Convention as set forth in the Official Call of the Convention, Mass Meeting, or Party Canvass called for the purpose of selecting delegates and alternates to that

Convention (other than a national Republican Convention), and who produces valid military identification or other proof of active-duty status shall be certified as a delegate and shall not be required to be elected as a delegate. The number of delegates certified in this manner shall count toward each unit's maximum allowable number of convention delegates.

Military Members who are certified as delegates pursuant to paragraph 6 that are unable to attend the convention in person due to obligations of their official military orders, shall have their votes cast within their unit delegation according to candidate preference ballots. Candidate preference ballots shall list the Military Member's rank order preference among candidates (i.e., first choice, second choice, third choice, etc.). Their votes shall be cast for the highest ranked choice candidate who remains eligible to receive a vote in a particular round of voting. Candidate preference ballots shall be made available by the Official Committee calling the convention no less than twenty (20) days prior to the convention and returned to the Chairman of the Official Committee that called the convention not less than three (3) days prior to the convention.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for the election, nomination, or selection to be a delegate or committee member at said meeting shall submit the attached form by mail, or in person (by appointment only – 540-910-1381) to Mr. Jacob Lipscomb by appointment at 1628 Monroe St., Waynesboro, VA 22980. Postmarks do not govern.

Candidates for the office of Chairman of the Waynesboro Republican Committee are required to pay a filing fee of \$200.00. The fee must be enclosed with the filing form for the office and is not refundable. Candidates for Unit Chairs should submit their paperwork which must be received no later than Saturday, March 23, 2024 at 5:00 pm. Postmarks do not govern. If only one candidate properly files, then said candidate shall be declared the Unit Chair and no mass meeting will be held.

Individuals filing to become a delegate, alternate or member of the Committee must have their paperwork received no later than March 23, 2024 at 5:00 pm. Postmarks do not govern. If fewer than the number of District delegates and Alternates allowed properly file, then they will be deemed to have been elected. If no mass meeting occurs, properly filed applications for membership to the Waynesboro Republican Committee will be deemed as approved.

Mass Meeting Registration

Photo ID is required for all participants at the Mass Meeting. It would be very helpful if participants bring their Voter ID Card with them. To speed the registration process at the Mass Meeting, it is recommended that persons who plan to attend as participants, and not as candidates, file a voluntary Pre-Registration Form. A copy of that form is attached. Participants who pre-register will avoid potentially long lines at the Registration Table. Registration will begin at 9:00 am. The Mass Meeting will be called to order at 10:00 am sharp. Persons who have not registered or are not in line to register by 10:00 am will have lost their opportunity to participate in the Mass Meeting.

Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee to participate in this mass meeting.
